Program:

Start in St. Gallen 08.30 A.M.

Van drive to Thusis/Grison - walk through the Viamala gorge - visit of the castles and villages in Domleschg - stop at the Canova Lake - dinner in Feldkirch on the way home.

Arrival back in St. Gallen at about 9 P.M.
